



TAP FEED mobile app version 2.0 release notes October - 2023

Introduction:

- The TAP FEED mobile app for iOS and Android is a field-proven, user-friendly and affordable feed management tool for all sizes of dairy and beef farms
- The new, TAP FEED mobile app version 2.0, offers enhanced functionality, including improved TAP FEED integration (TAP FEED subscription required) and an improved user experience
- The FEED mobile app continues to be a free download and will also continue to offer the free "Guest" mode

New FEED app functionality:











- So far, the FEED app only supported standard recipes. With the release of FEED app 2.0 the FEED app now also supports the different recipe types available in <u>TAP FEED Pro</u>
 - Add ingredient to base mix recipe (Add additional ingredient(s) to base recipe)
 - Refusal substitution recipe (record und (re)use refusals in a load)
 - First ingredient resizes recipe (Resize total recipe based on first ingredient weight)

Note: Please check the TAP FEED pro help files for more details on the recipe types and how to program them.

Group advance delay setting:

- The advance delay setting has been improved. Next to the "Ingredient advance delay" setting, the FEED app now also offers a "Pen advance delay" setting.
- The "Pen advance delay" setting can be found in the "Batch settings".
 - Select 0 60 second pen delay time. 0 is manual advance


Guest mode:

- Guest mode now offers two methods for entering a recipe.
 - o Ingredient amount in weight per head
 - o (NEW) Ingredient amount in percent of total weight per head
